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DES MOINES SOCIAL CLUB'S AFTERNOON ARTS PROGRAM

WHAT The Des Moines Social Club is proud to announce the pilot semester for our Afternoon Arts Program, allowing elementary age students to experience a wide variety of artistic classes and workshops spanning multiple disciplines.

WHO The program is open to any elementary (Kindergarten through fifth grades) student able to get to the Des Moines Social Club after school. For students attending Walnut Street School, and adult chaperone will walk students to The Des Moines Social Club.

CLASSES

THEATER: A semester long play created by students. Students will be able to self-identify whether they wish to perform or to be backstage, working on sets and costumes. All ages take this class together.

VISUAL ART M/W and T/Th Visual Art blocks will be different to allow for a variety of media and projects.

DANCE Covering various styles, this class will teach students the value of self-expression through movement.

MUSIC This class will cover group singing, percussion, and songwriting.

WORKSHOPS: Certain Fridays will be reserved for special one-time workshops, covering topics such as papermaking, poetry, zine making, and more!

SAMPLE WEEK:

Friday: Varies. Either M/W blocks, T/Th blocks, or Theater. Occasionally used to teach one-off classes.

BLOCKS: Students will be split into Kindergarten through second grade and third through fifth grades age groups. They will take separate classes during Block 1, and switch for Block 2. This will allow instructors to best tailor their lessons to those age groups. If lesson plans merit, all students may occasionally take classes together. The theater class will typically bring both groups together.
